16-17 May, 2011 Ankara

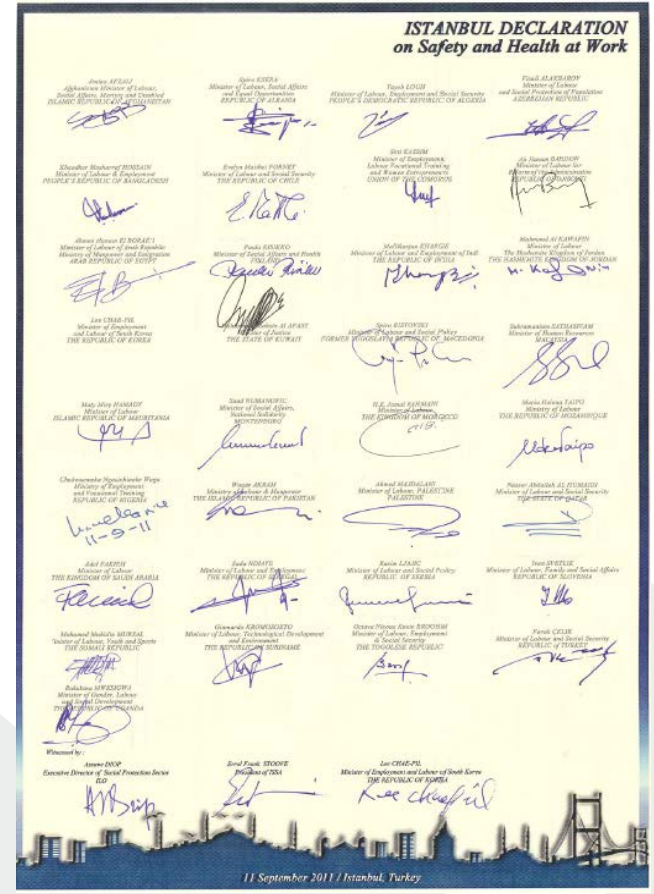
- Kick-off meeting for the purpose of creating awareness about OSH in OIC countries and establish a common network between participant countries.
- From 15 different countries 16 participant (Turkey, Albania, Bangladesh, Egypt, Iraq, Jordan, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Malaysia, Morocco, Oman, Palestine, Pakistani, United Arab Emirates, Senegal)
- A final declaration was published.
