Dissemination and implementation of the "Good Healthy School" at international level

Brief report (March 2023)

To support the work of the TF 1, in February 2023 a new post for research, promoted by the Statutory Accident Insurance for the public sector in North Rhine-Westphalia (UK NRW), was established at Leuphana University Lüneburg.

From now on, Neele Grandt (Centre for Applied Health Sciences, Leuphana University Lüneburg) will be actively involved in ENETOSH and the TF 1, using the various ENETOSH contacts to further promote and disseminate the "Good Healthy School" approach worldwide. Over the next three years, TF 1 will work on the following fields of action:

Cooperation: A status quo analysis on the different individuals and organizations able and willing to support the technical and / or organizational development of the "Good Healthy School" concept will be conducted. Different partners and initiatives will be identified with which a close collaboration can be established in the future.

Network Meeting: To further improve the "Good Healthy School" approach and to develop effective dissemination and implementation strategies, two international network meetings will be conducted.

Products: To identify best practice models that are in line with the "Good Healthy School" approach and to find similar approaches, the ENETOSH database and other relevant database systems will be reviewed. We would like to relaunch the "Good Healthy School" website of ENETOSH and identify entry or contact points where national and international developments in education and health can be linked to the concept of a "Good Healthy School".

Evaluation: Lastly, it is planned to review and / or develop new evaluation tools for the "Good Healthy School" and similar approaches in the field of OSH.
