I. The Parties

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered into by and between:

The IGSAP was established with the aim of working as an organization that responds to a wide range of safety needs across industries, and through its operation and promotion, to improve the social value of safety. Its activities include industrial safety promotion and support activities, research and dissemination activities related to safety and productivity improvement, activities such as safety study groups, information exchange meetings, and international exchange activities, development, implementation, operation, and dissemination activities of systems related to safety certification, safety-related standard creation and standardization activities, educational activities such as safety courses, safety award activities.

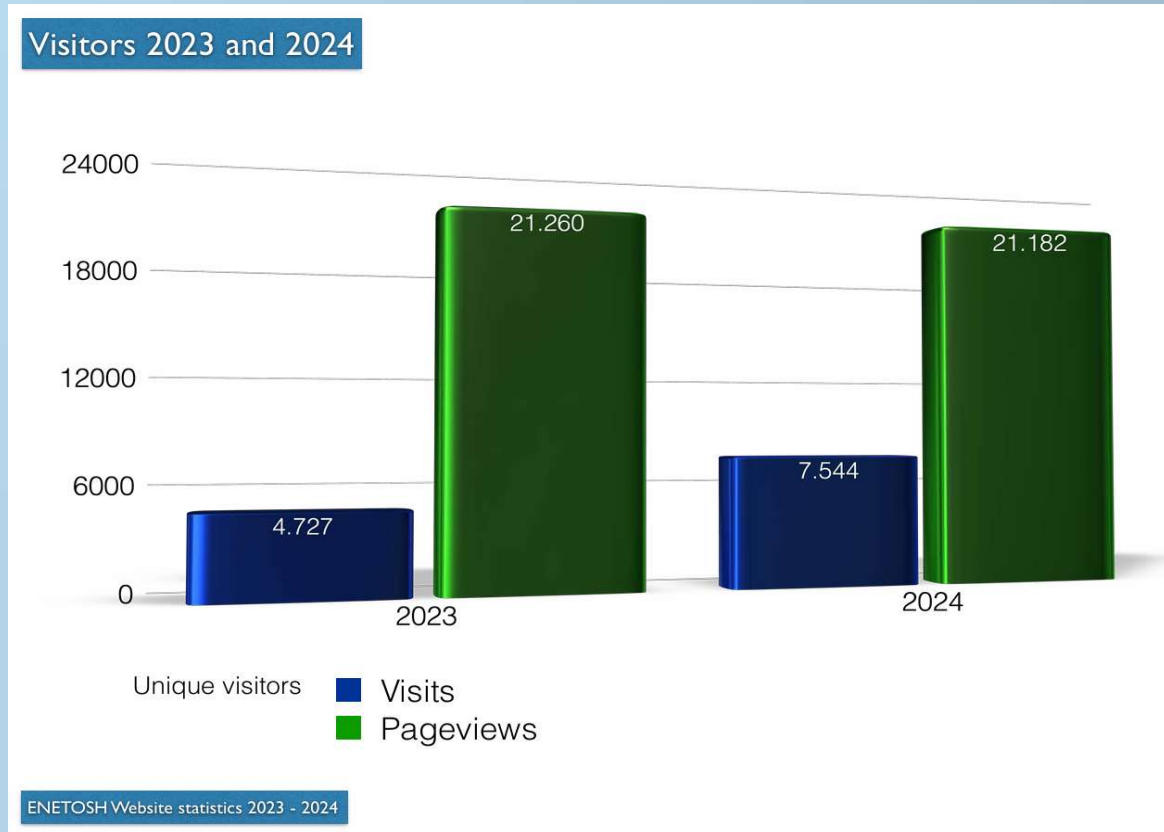
